Students learn how to use different sizes of dots to highlight shapes of an object.







Students learn to draw themselves with markers, and be bold with colours just like Andy.












P.6 WHERE'S WALLY ?

Students learn to create their own puzzles, from character design, perspective consideration, to the use of colours.





The Artaholic members made a tiger to celebrate the school's 20th anniversary.




6B Tse Hayley Hay Yee

The reason that I draw Albert Einstein is because he made great contribution to science, his works are so inspiring.


