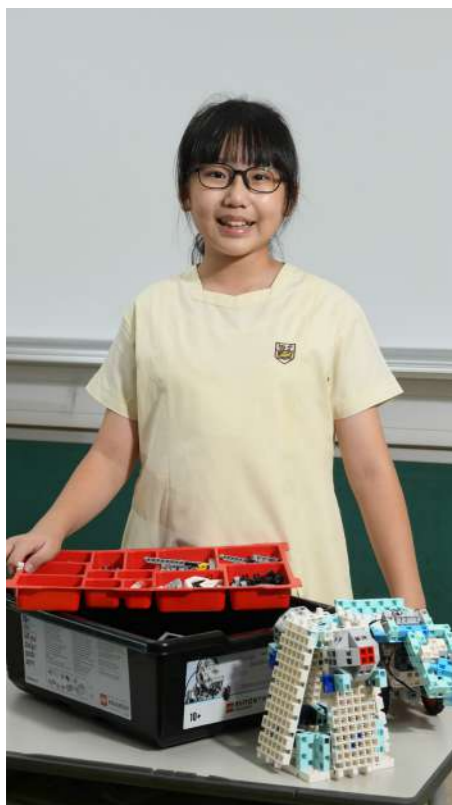
Knowledge requires learning, and learning requires being humble.

Jaylen is a very polite child, you can be infected by his smile every time you see him.

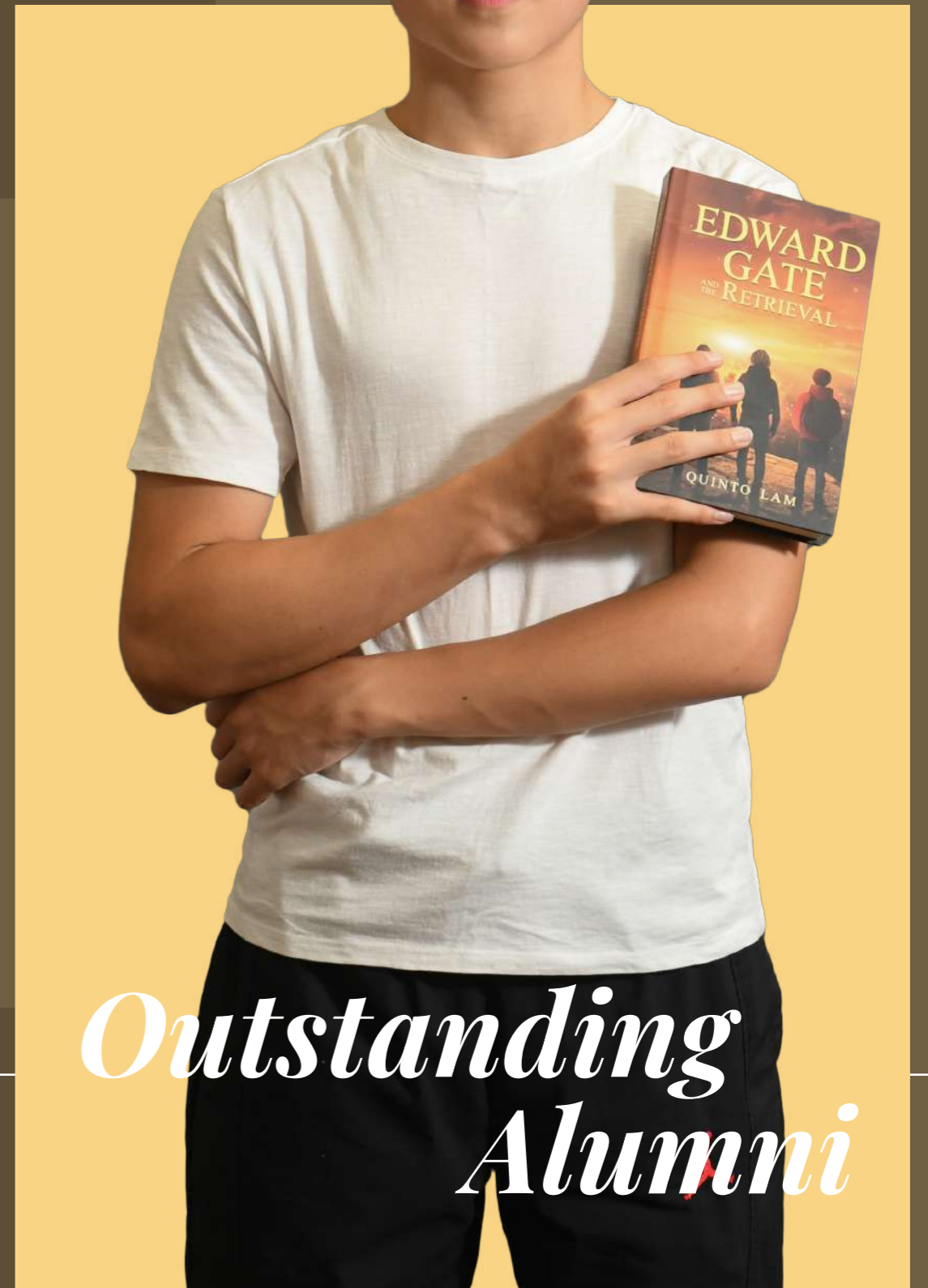

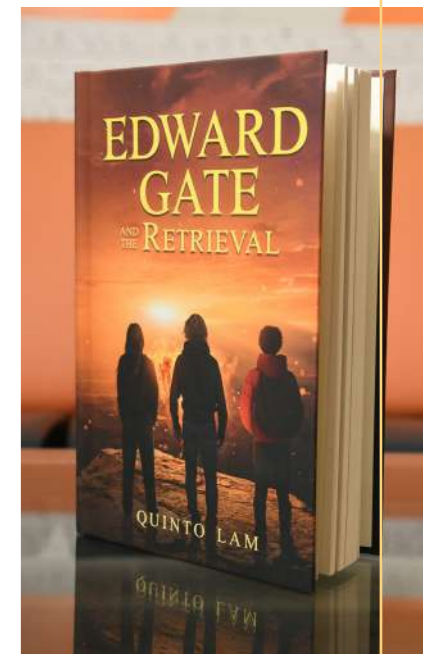
