Background

The school's sponsoring body is Wofoo Foundation Ltd., a charitable non-government subvented organization established by Dr. Joseph Lee in May 1997. The Foundation aims at providing social services and is committed to the betterment of the Hong Kong community. It focuses on the needs of the young and the elderly, and in response to the 2000 Education Reform, it started to offer its support to the children of Hong Kong in the provision of quality education. Since early childhood education is the basis for life education, the Foundation chose to open a school at the primary level under the direct subsidy scheme. The W F Joseph Lee Primary School was founded in September 2002 against this background.

Philosophy

It is our belief that the overall aims of education are to enable every child to attain all-around development in the domains of ethics, intellect, physique, social skills and aesthetics. Therefore, along with the academic learning, education in the new Millennium should also involve the enhancement of self-esteem, social interaction and responsibility, personal growth, creative imagination, independent thinking and the right attitude in using information technology. Our School

We are a direct subsidy primary school, adopting a school based management mode (SBM). The majority of our students come from comparatively well off families living in Yuen Long, Tuen Mun and Tin Shui Wai in the New Territories. About 70% of them come to school by school bus, the rest by private car or on foot.

With 5 classes in each level, we have altogether 30 classes. We are housed in a 7-storey Y2K designed building standing on 6 200 square metres in northern Tin Shui Wai, New Territories. The school is equipped with 30 standard classrooms, 1 hall, 1 library, 1 dancing room, 2 basketball courts and 7 special rooms for teaching information technology, language, general studies, music and art. One multipurpose room has been converted into a multi-media learning centre with 36 computers. With ample resources, we are able to provide a happy and motivating learning environment for our students.

Following the guidelines laid out by the EDB, our school-based curriculum infuses the concept of multiple intelligences learning. It also adopts a trilingual and biliterate approach to teaching to enhance students' language skills in communication and learning. As for pastoral care, the whole school approach is being practised.

Achievements and Reflections on Major Concerns

Priority Task 1:

Goal 1: Enhance teaching effectiveness in order to develop students to be self-directed learners

Achievements

To achieve the goal, learning circle was held monthly this school year. Different subjects teachers including Chinese, English, Mathematics, Science and General Studies have shared how they planned their lessons in order to train students to be self-directed learners. From their sharings, school ensured that teachers understood and matched with school goals. In the questionnaire survey conducted among teachers, 94% of the teachers agreed that the learning circle could enhance their professional knowledge in self-directed learning and gave them more ideas of effective learning and teaching.

To ensure the effectiveness in achieving the goal, regular lesson observation has been conducted throughout the year. From the feedback of lesson observation form, all teachers tried using open-ended questioning skills while 81% of the teachers have shown ‘volleyball’ questioning skills in classroom teaching. For self-directed learning, over 95% of the teachers have attempted strategies which were able to develop classroom practices enhancing self-directed learning. Through lesson observations, we could see that more and more teachers are able to use different techniques to cultivate students to be independent learners.

Starting from Term 2, the good practices developed in the lesson implementation and team planning periods of each unit/module for P1 to P6 were systematically filed into team planning boxes (TP Box) for easy reference and future betterment.

To cater for learning diversity and integrate the e-learning elements, the contact hours of Chinese and English subjects were increased by one hour per week. Besides, students tried to apply the language presentation skills in the GS and Science projects through STEM exhibition day organized at the year end. The display of students’ work can serve as good examples of self-directed learning.

From homework sharing and book inspection, most students have built habits of pre-lesson preparation and note-taking in Chinese, English and Mathematics. An online e-learning platform was served as extended learning for students after lessons.

Students are assigned to share their daily writing (English), the Math Journal and news reports (GS) in class regularly. This practice developed a culture of appreciation and recognition among students

themselves.

Buddy Reading Program was held in January. Students of higher grade served as student-teachers of their counterparts in lower grades. Through the shared reading time, elder buddies enjoyed reading the stories to the younger ones with W5H techniques. They were well-prepared during the ICT lessons before the activity. The younger buddies showed their thankfulness with their warmest message through email. Over 96% of teachers agreed that the activity enhanced the communication and interaction between students. It was a very meaningful activity which allowed students to learn communication skills through supporting peer fellow classmates.

To strengthen students' leadership skills, 109 prefects, 14 house captains, 15 Math ambassadors, 26 PE ambassadors, 27 music ambassadors, 20 IT ambassadors, 25 VA ambassadors and 40 library prefects were selected to receive relevant training, serve and lead in different contexts.

Reflection

This year, enhancing teachers' awareness on different teaching strategies has been achieved. Next year, our goal is to further synthesize the specific strategies into our lessons, which includes but is not limited to the following: five senses teaching methodology, "volleyball" questioning skills, note-taking techniques and most importantly, catering for learning diversity.

In consideration of the stakeholder survey, the students' point of view on teachers' encouragement to students was 3.5. It showed that students were eager to get more appreciation and encouragement from teachers. Besides the diversity of learning activity during lessons showed that there was an obvious gap between the students' and teachers' perception which were 3.8 and 4.3 respectively. It indicates that there was a gap between the students' and teachers' perceptions. With the above findings, our teachers should concentrate much on providing more positive reinforcement in their daily interactions with students and designing more diversified learning activities in order to bridge the gap between the two perceptions.

Priority Task 2:

Goal 2: Develop a distinctive school culture through the development of a reflective school ethos and deliberate cultivation of the “16 Habits of Mind”

Achievements

In 2015/16, sharing sessions about the 16 Habits of Mind (16 HOMs) were held during assemblies on Mondays. Most of the students had better understanding about the four selected HOMs in four different categories which are:

- (A) “Learning Outcome” - Striving for accuracy & precision
- (B) “Learning Process” - Questioning and posing problems
- (C) “Human Relationship”- Listen to others with understanding and empathy
- (D) “Thinking Attitude” - Thinking interdependently

According to the statistical record from students’ Firefly Scheme Booklet, 67% of students can achieve our set requirement. A series of bookmark was also awarded to students when they attained a certain level of criteria.

The campus TV provided seven different channels (七育頻道): Morality, Intellect, Physicality, Sociability, Aesthetics, Affection and Spirituality for students to acquire positive attitude through Moral Education. 60% of the whole school students had chances to get involved in the programme, such as the reporter, presenters etc. Most students enjoyed the programme and their participation enhanced their presentation skills. Besides a crew of 12 students had been selected to be the Campus TV Ambassadors, they were trained for video taping, editing and broadcasting of the TV programme every morning)

Our Music teachers collaborated with our social worker to produce the song sharing programme via Campus TV on Thanksgiving Day, Christmas, Chinese New Year and final examination period for their teachers and classmates. It helped develop a loving and caring relationship among all members of the school. The recommended songs had been collected from students to enhance their involvement in the activities.

To generate a warm and joyful atmosphere, four birthday parties were held in class for celebrating students who were born in those months. Birthday gifts were presented to those students. This activity helped to build rapport among teachers and students. Moreover, it helped promote teacher-student interaction in the long run.

Reflection

In order to train our students to be more positive and self-initiated, the House League Buddy Scheme will be implemented more systematically with a framework of “Life Education”. We hope to build up their character next year. More students will be recognised in different ways under certain criteria, students who attain goals in 4 categories of different levels will be awarded with the badges of bronze, silver and gold.

Due to the technical issues, the campus TV programme was pre-recorded. It was recommended to bring the programme back to live next year, so as to provide a better platform for boosting our students’ confidence and ability to deal with ad hoc tasks.

Priority Task 3:

Goal 3: Build a vigorous and vibrant learning community for all our stakeholders

Achievements

In order to build a vigorous and vibrant learning community for all our stakeholders, we have organized a series of programs and activities for our teachers, students, parents and graduates.

Regular peer lesson observations were arranged for teachers throughout the year. New teachers observed lessons conducted by panel heads in the early October in order to grasp the school-based requirements in teaching. Besides, subject panels were working closely with new teachers under the mentorship scheme. Most of the new teachers agreed that the mentorship scheme was effective.

This year, we joined the International Alliance for Invitational Education (IAIE) programme to cultivate a welcoming school. The core members of IAIE group attended several seminars (from November to March) to equip themselves with the skills in implementing IAIE in the school. A representative from HKIAIE was invited to review our present practice, some constructive suggestions on how to infuse the 5 domains (5P: Policy, People, Program, Process and Place) were given to the core group members. The members organized a workshop for our staff to introduce the concepts of IAIE. Positive responses were received from our colleagues.

Teachers were also encouraged to join different seminars or workshops in their related aspects. More than 40 teachers have shared their learning experience during staff meetings and panel meetings. Most of the teachers agreed that the sharing sessions were useful and matched the school goals.

For our students, we have provided a series of training programmes to the subject ambassadors, prefects and library prefects. Most of the participated students agreed that they could apply what they learnt in their daily life. Some of the training activities were conducted out of school. For example, the Day Camp for uniform groups, the Day Camp for P4, the GS Trip to Mainland China for P5 and the Science Trip to Taiwan for P6. All of these activities were proven to strengthen students' self management skill and a sense of responsibility.

Parents are good partners of our school. In order to educate our parents to match with our school goal, some workshops were organized to enhance their understanding on self-directed learning. For example the parent workshop "Easy ways to initiate the children as active learner" was organized in February. According to the survey, more than 90% of the participants agreed that the contents were

meaningful and useful. The parents had better understanding on different strategies in helping their children to take active role in their learning.

Alumni are our collaborative partners. To enhance the cohesion of graduates, a Buddy BBQ Night was held in the evening in March. More than 90 graduates from the past ten years (Year 2005 to 2015), 40 parents and teachers joined the BBQ. The gathering provided a good platform for them to meet their peers and teachers. Graduates not only proactively participated in our alumni gatherings, but also assisted teachers in coaching our school teams, such as basketball, volleyball and football in order to maintain a sense of belongings.

To strengthen the relationship with the community, more than 400 stakeholders including teachers, students, parents and graduates joined a meaningful activity called “Hong Kong Water Race 2016”. It aimed to arouse the importance of saving water. 85% of the participants agreed that it was a very meaningful activity and could arouse their concern for the society.

Reflection

During the past two years, we put efforts in updating our curriculum to meet with educational trend. We will share our teaching outcomes such as self-directed learning strategies and 16 Habits of Mind to our parents in a more systematic schedule throughout next year.

Matching with our 15th Anniversary next year, different celebration activities will be organized for our students, parents, teachers and alumni in order to nurture a more cohesive relationship among all the stakeholders.

A. Our Learning and Teaching

The review in 2015-2016 showed that our teachers started to pose high order thinking questions and “volleyball” questioning technique. With accumulated experiences attained by teachers through team planning periods and learning circles over the past two years, teachers are now having more confidence to design a school-based curriculum that matches with educational trend to integrate different subjects in order to nurture students with a holistic mind and a proactive learning attitude. In addition, we concern much about the effectiveness of teaching. The lesson study would be arranged after observation of same level lessons. For other details, please refer to the achievement and the reflection of Goad 1.

B. Support for Student Development

Character building is a core element in primary education. The positive thinking attitude of students was nurtured in our Moral Education Program. For example, workshops were organized during weekly assembly, for special needs students we have organized supporting program for non-Chinese speaking students (NCS) and the Understanding Adolescent Project to increase the psychological resilience of students to properly adapt the stress and adversity. The theme “FAITH” which is one of our school motto was our main focus this year. Next year, the theme “LOVE” will be our focus. “Life Education” will be structured by honing “Love” through four domains: Love Yourself, Love Another, Love our Environment and Respect Life. We aim to cultivate a thankful mind to all of our stakeholders including parents and alumni. “To love, be thankful” will also be our slogan through the implementation of Life Education to celebrate our 15th Anniversary.

C. Student Performance

Our P6 students took part in the Secondary School Places Allocation for allocation of Secondary 1 places. 91% of students were admitted into schools of their first-three choice in the discretionary places placing stage of the Secondary School Places Allocation exercise. All of the P6 students were allocated to 44 different secondary schools in which 52% were admitted in Direct Subsidy Secondary Schools and 48% were admitted to the Aided schools respectively.

D. Non-academic performance

We value not only academic performance, but also expect students to be well-mannered, pleasant, collaborative and confident. Therefore, we aimed to optimize the learning opportunities for all students through participation of different competitions and activities. Details can be referred to Appendix 1.
